#### **Extemp Prep**

#### **Extra Classroom Possibilities**

#### **Alumni Welcome & Conference Center**

Pay-to-use facility on campus. Meeting rooms and a large ballroom available.

#### Summary

Based on current room usage, the UW-Oshkosh campus will be able to host preliminary rounds Thursday through Sunday. Our campus is relatively compact. The walking distance from the Reeve Union to the furthest academic building is less than five minutes. The walk between academic buildings used for the tournament is even shorter.

# **On Campus Option**

If staying on-campus, a variety of larger spaces are available for Semi-final and Final rounds. These spaces include:
